Safeguarding Policy

The following policy was agreed at the meeting of trustees held on 5th February 2024.

1. We are committed to:
 - promoting an environment and culture of safety for all
 - the care, nurture of, and respectful pastoral ministry with all children and all adults
 - the safeguarding and protection of all vulnerable persons - children, young people, and vulnerable adults
 - the establishing of safe, caring communities which provide a loving environment where there is a culture of 'informed vigilance' as to the dangers of abuse.
2. We will carefully recruit, support, and train all those with any responsibility for children, young people or vulnerable adults within the Church.
3. We will respond without delay to every complaint made which suggests that an adult, child or young person may have been harmed, co-operating with the police and local authority in any investigation and we will have a clear reporting procedure in place.
4. We will seek to work with anyone who has suffered abuse, developing with them an appropriate ministry of informed pastoral care.
5. We will seek to challenge any abuse of power, especially by anyone in a position of trust.
6. We will seek to offer pastoral care and support, including risk assessments, supervision, and referral to the proper authorities, to any member of our church community known to have offended against a child, young person or vulnerable adult.
7. We will expect external users who hire our premises to follow the principles in this policy.
8. In all these principles we will follow statute, guidance and recognised good practice, including the guidance documents issued by the Moravian Church or other denomination if they lead in a partnership.
9. We will advise the National Safeguarding Lead if we receive a Disclosure (DBS or AccessNI) which is 'blemished' or 'positive'.
10. We will review this policy annually, check that our policy and procedures are up to date, and supply a copy of the updated policy to the National Safeguarding Lead. We will display a copy in all our buildings, and on our website.
